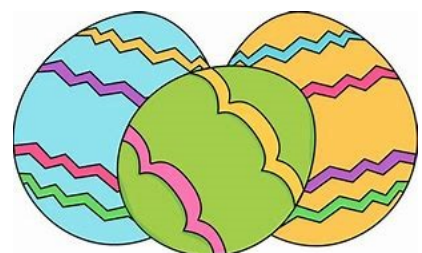


Easter Eggs Wanted!
