Park Room—£22 per hour

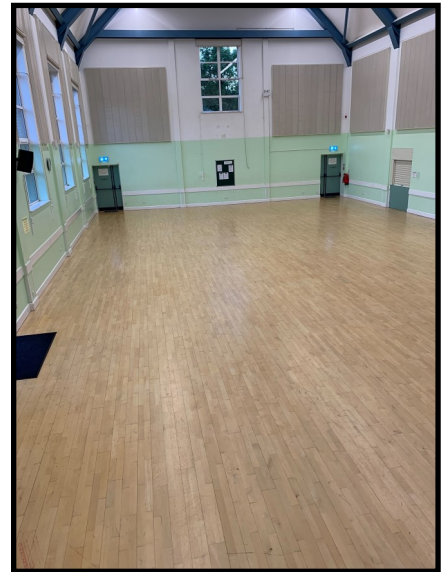
